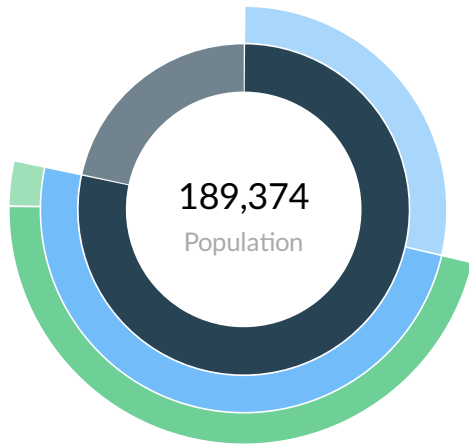
Median household income is **\$11.9K above** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by **16.0%** since 2015, growing by 26,082. Population is expected to increase by **9.9%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 18,806.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by **11.7%** in Ellis County, TX from 55,357 to **61,846**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.1% by 8.6%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 64.6% to 63.5% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.0% of Ellis County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.1% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Warehousing and Storage.

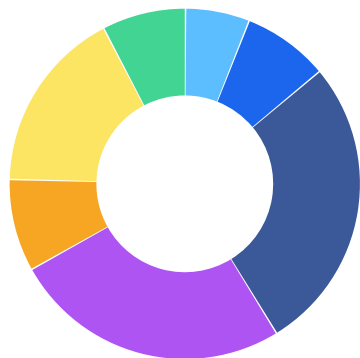

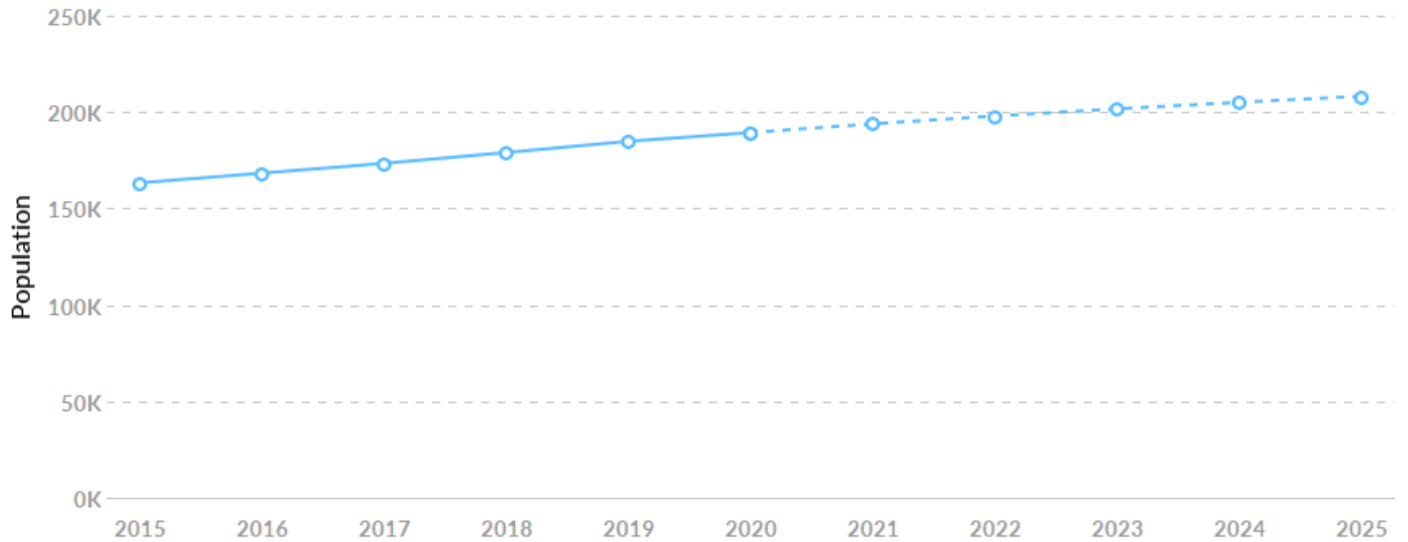

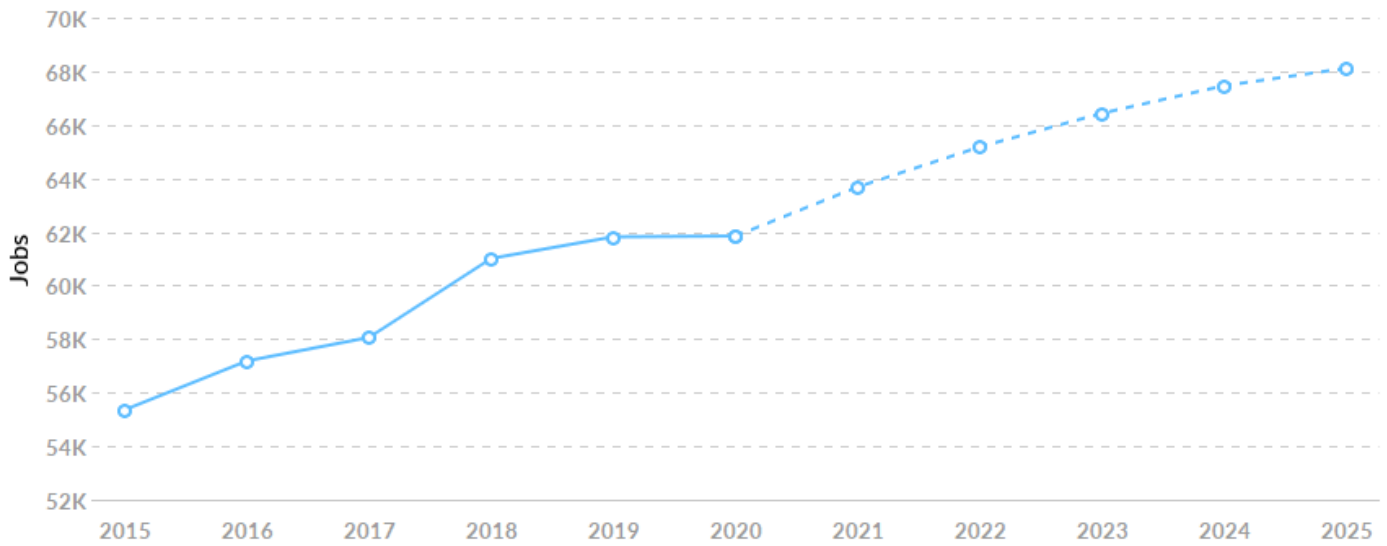

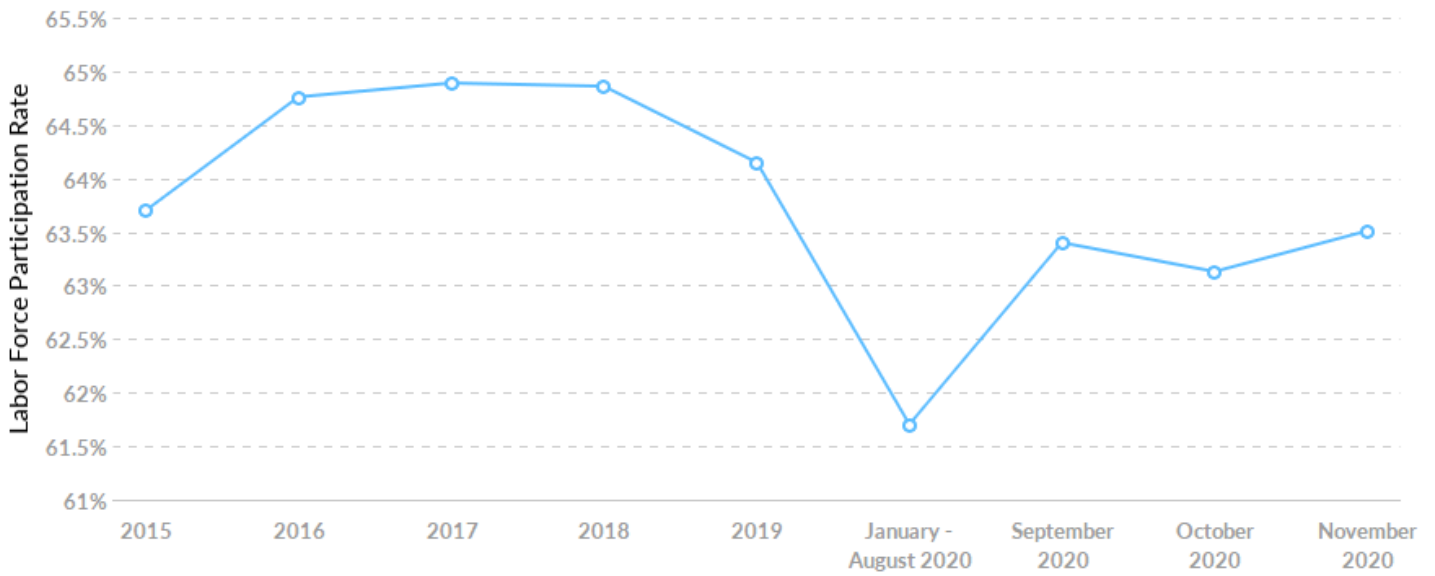
Job Trends

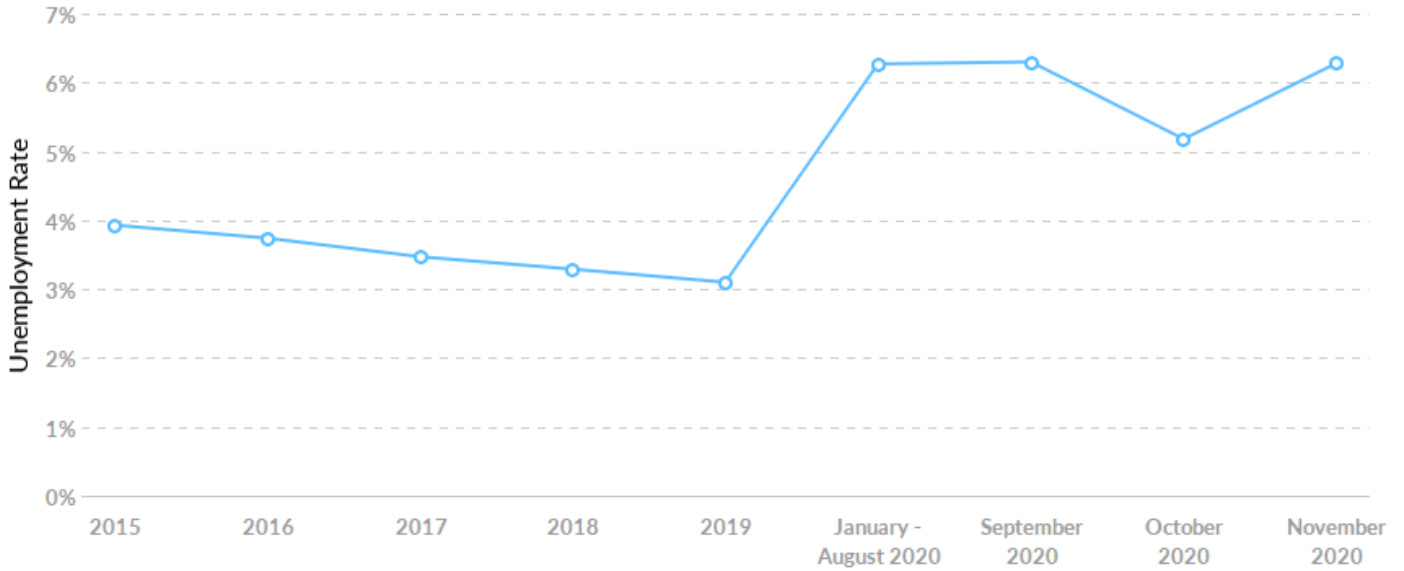

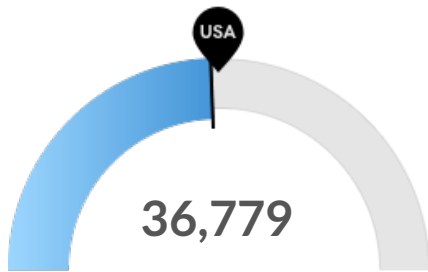
Unemployment Rate Trends

Ellis County, TX had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 6.28%, **increasing from 3.93%** 5 years before.



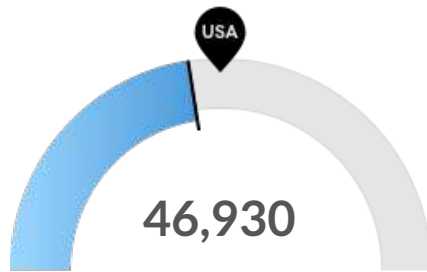

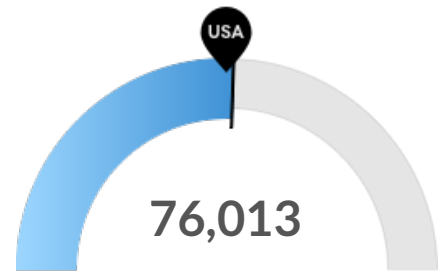
Millennials

Ellis County, TX has 36,779 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 38,108.



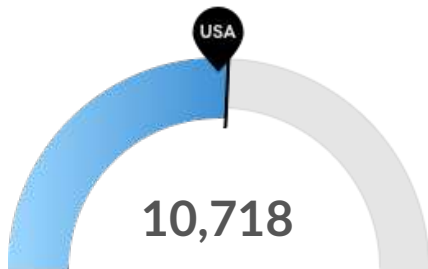
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Ellis County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 54,341 people 55 or older, while there are 46,930 here.



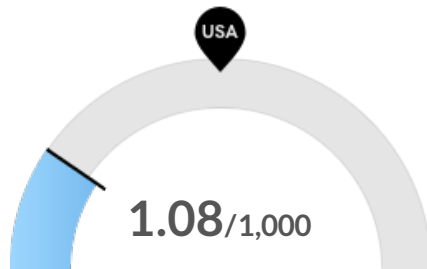
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in Ellis County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 73,724 racially diverse people, while there are 76,013 here.



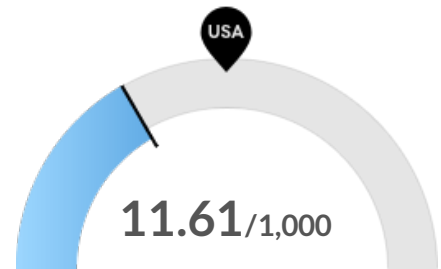
Veterans

Ellis County, TX has 1.08 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

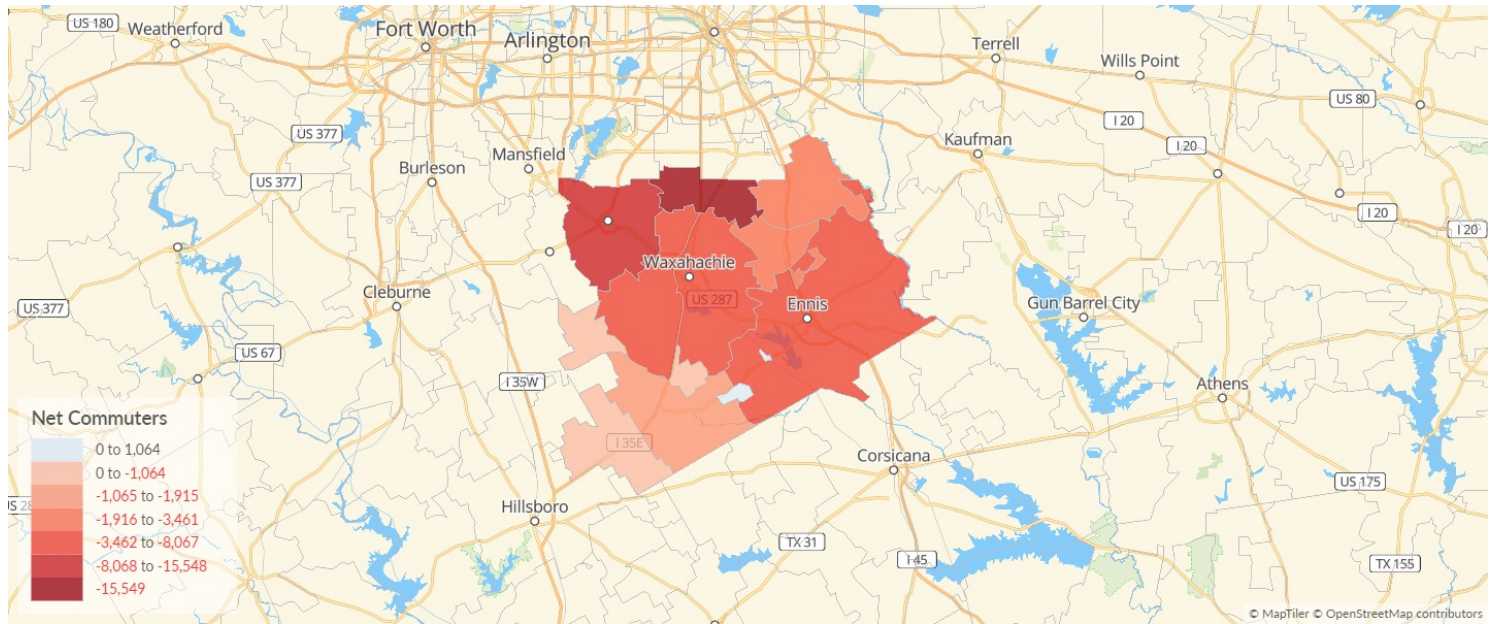


Property Crime

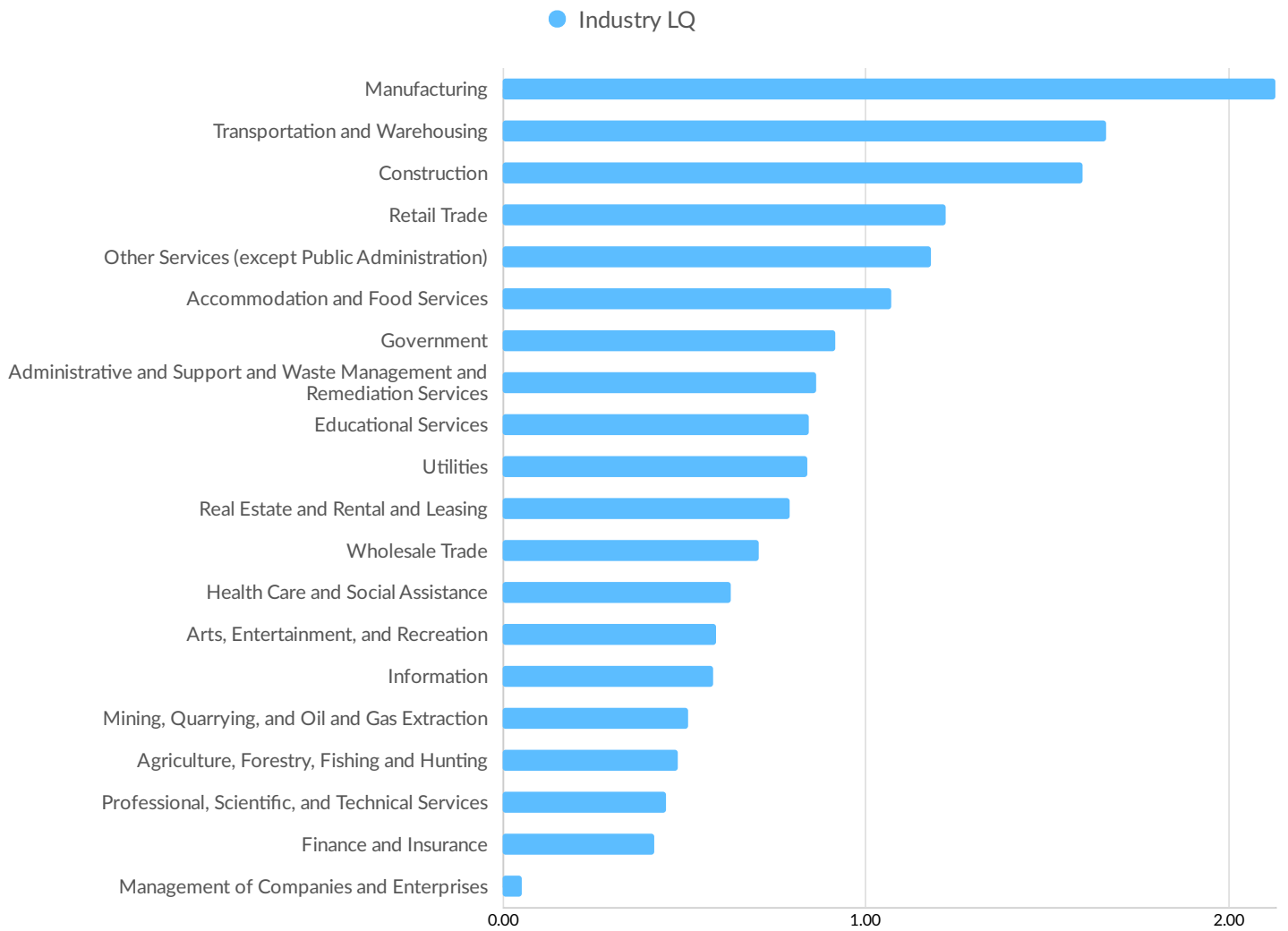

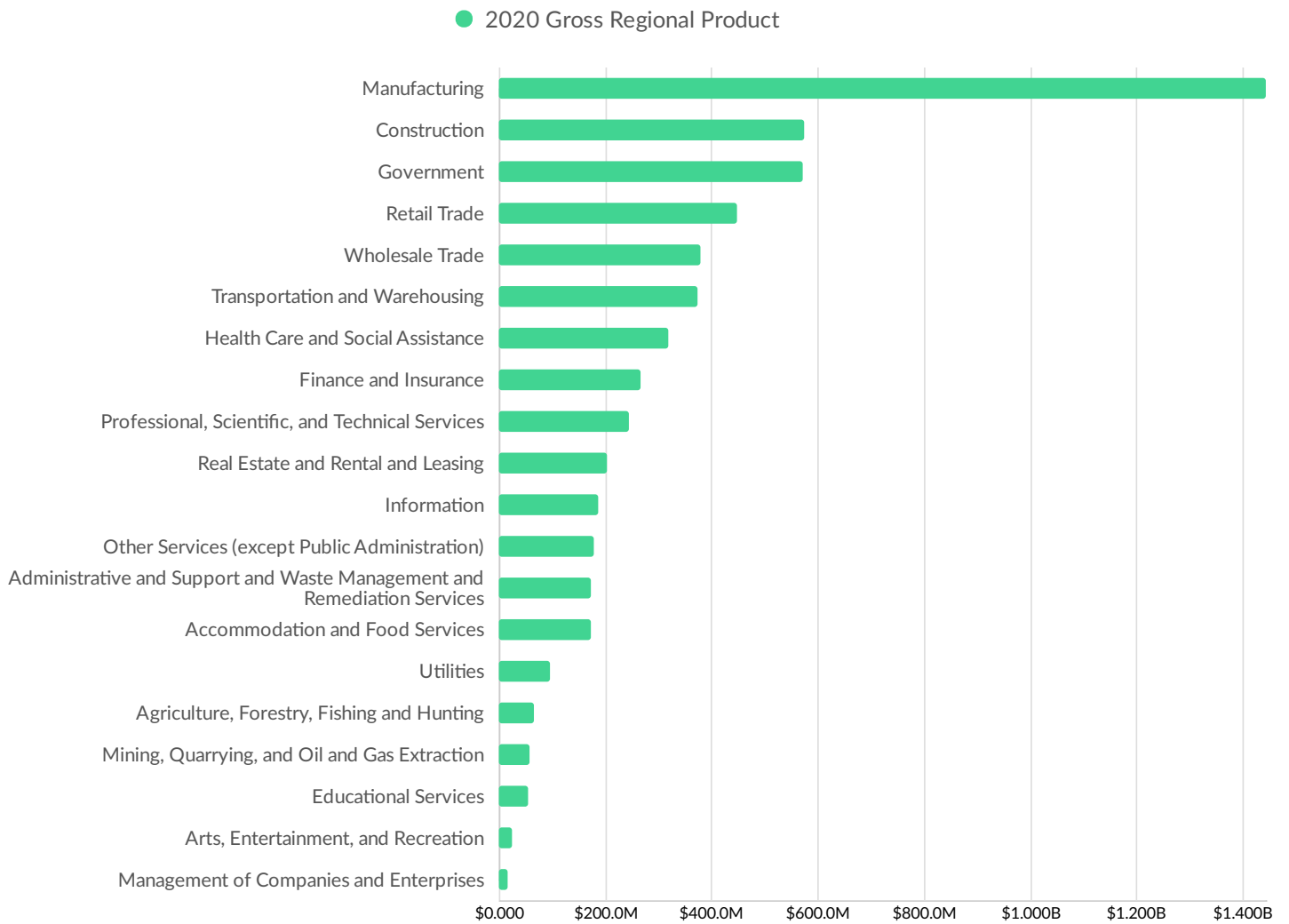

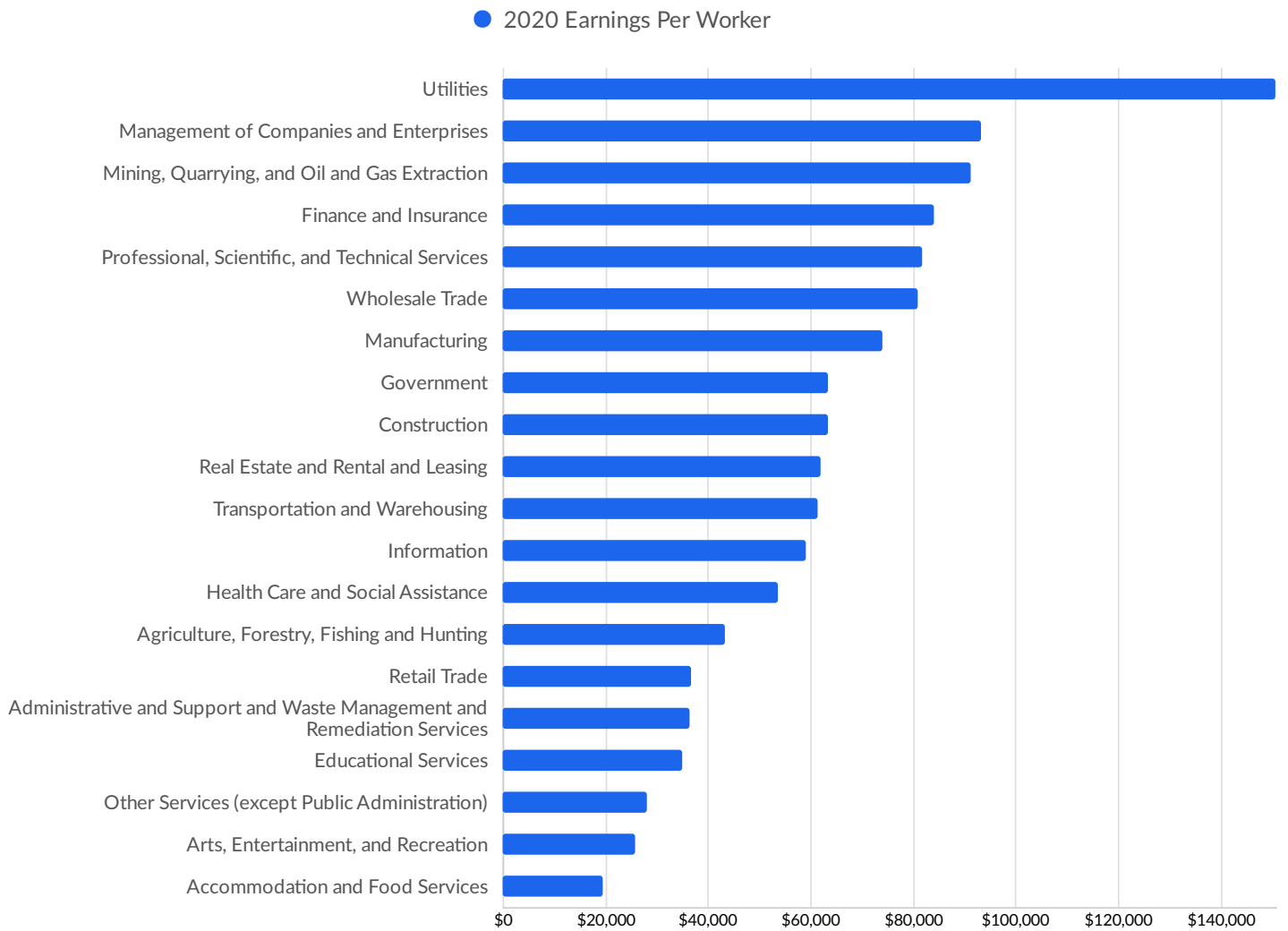
Top Industry LQ

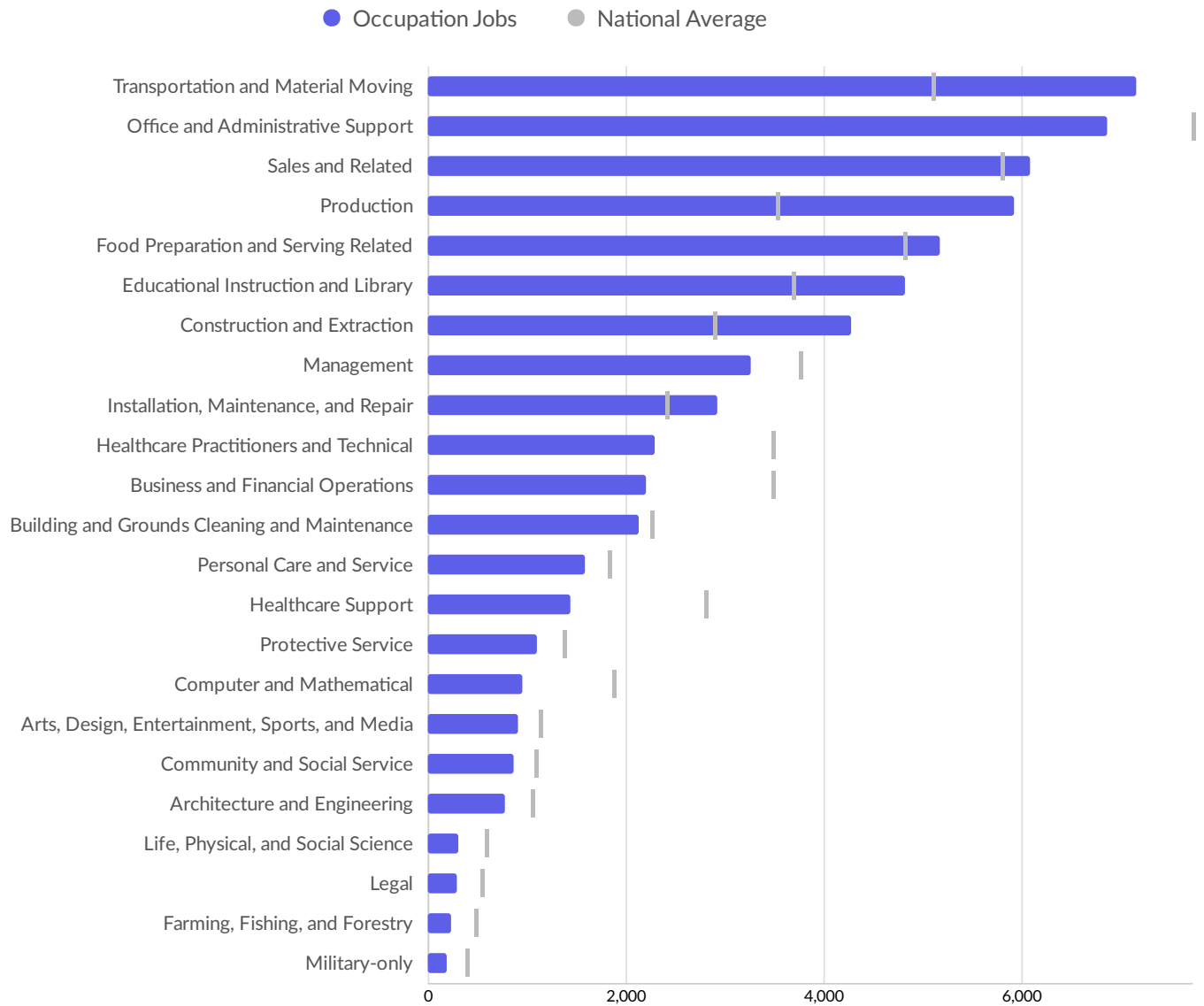

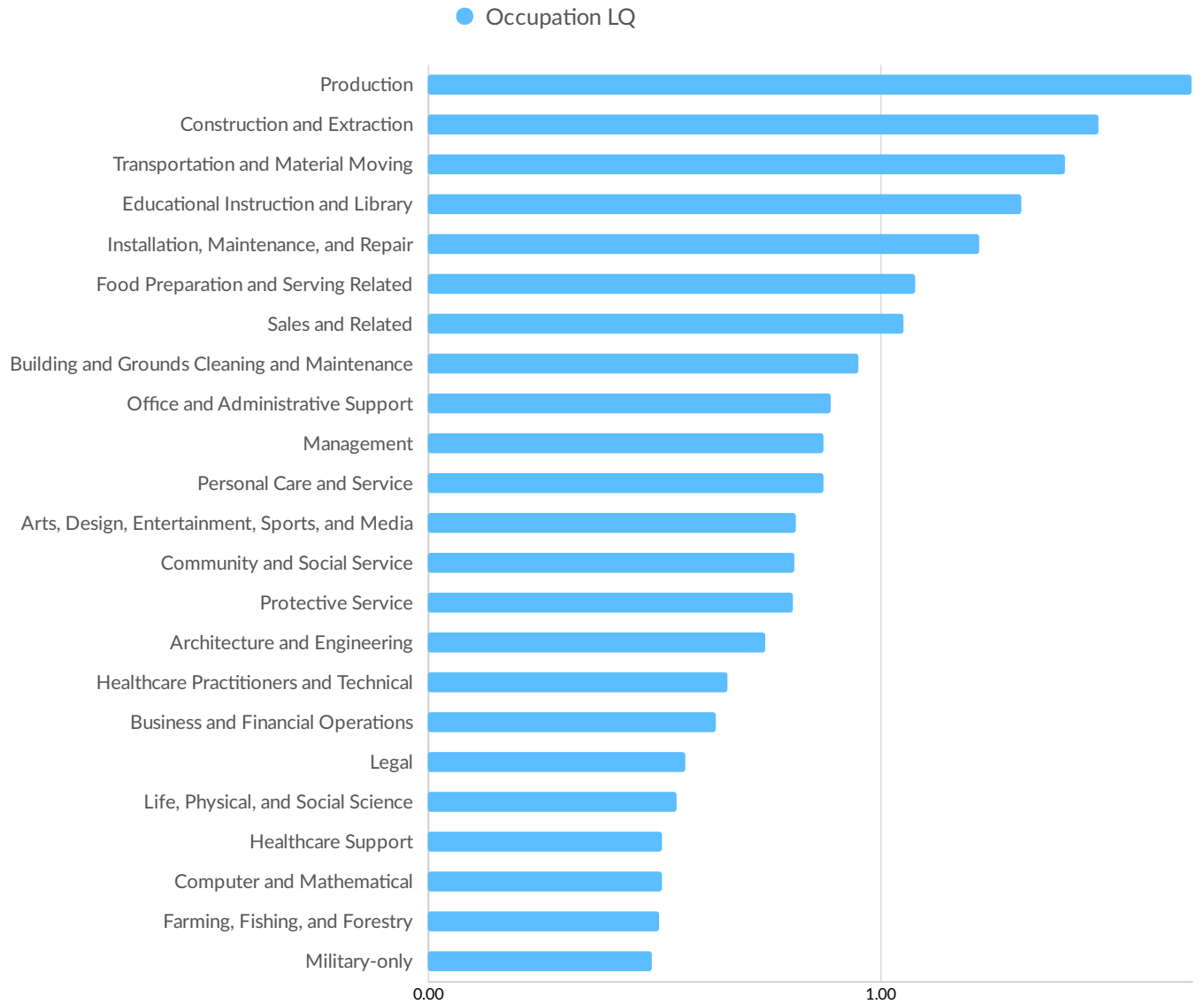

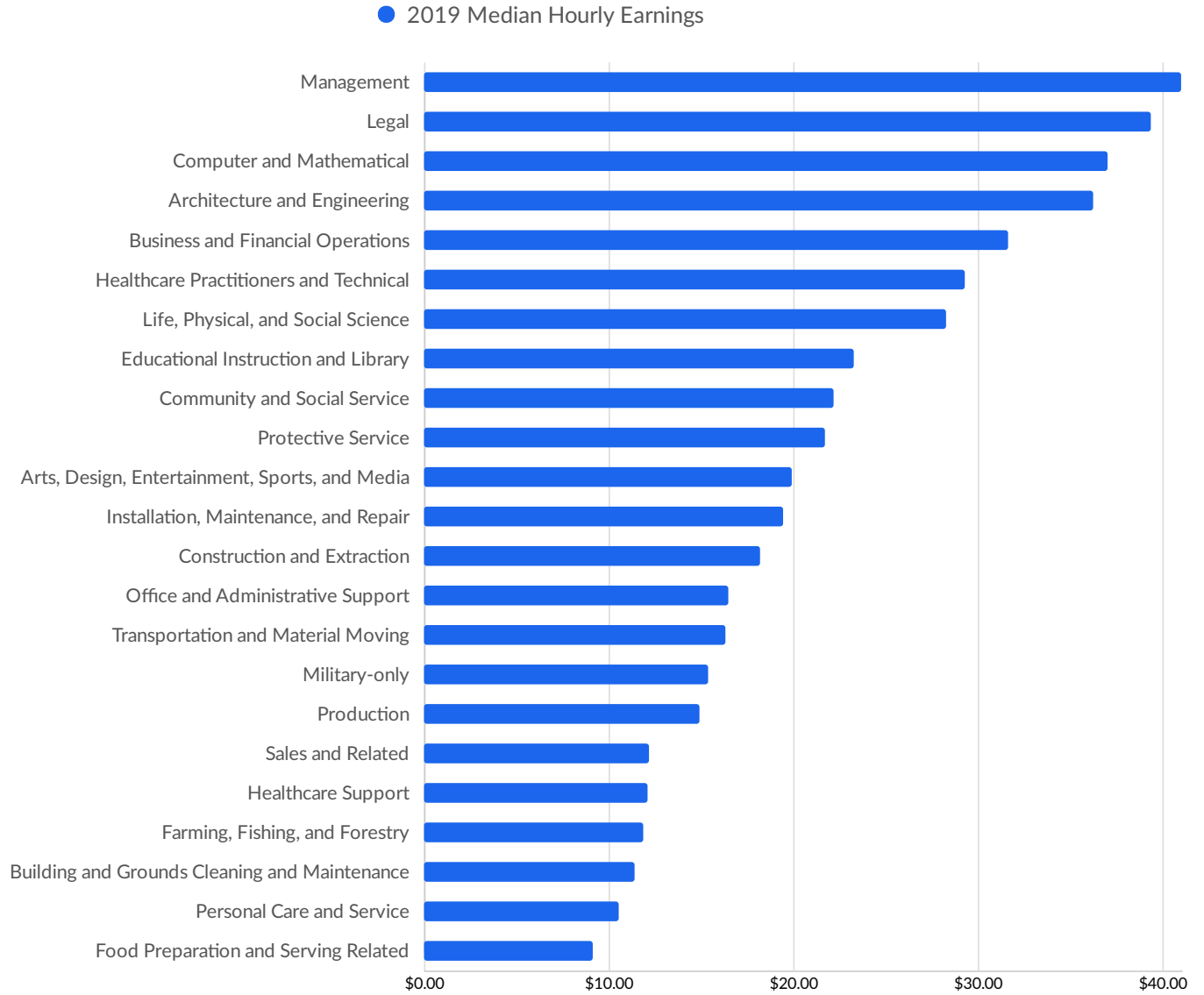
Top Growing Occupations



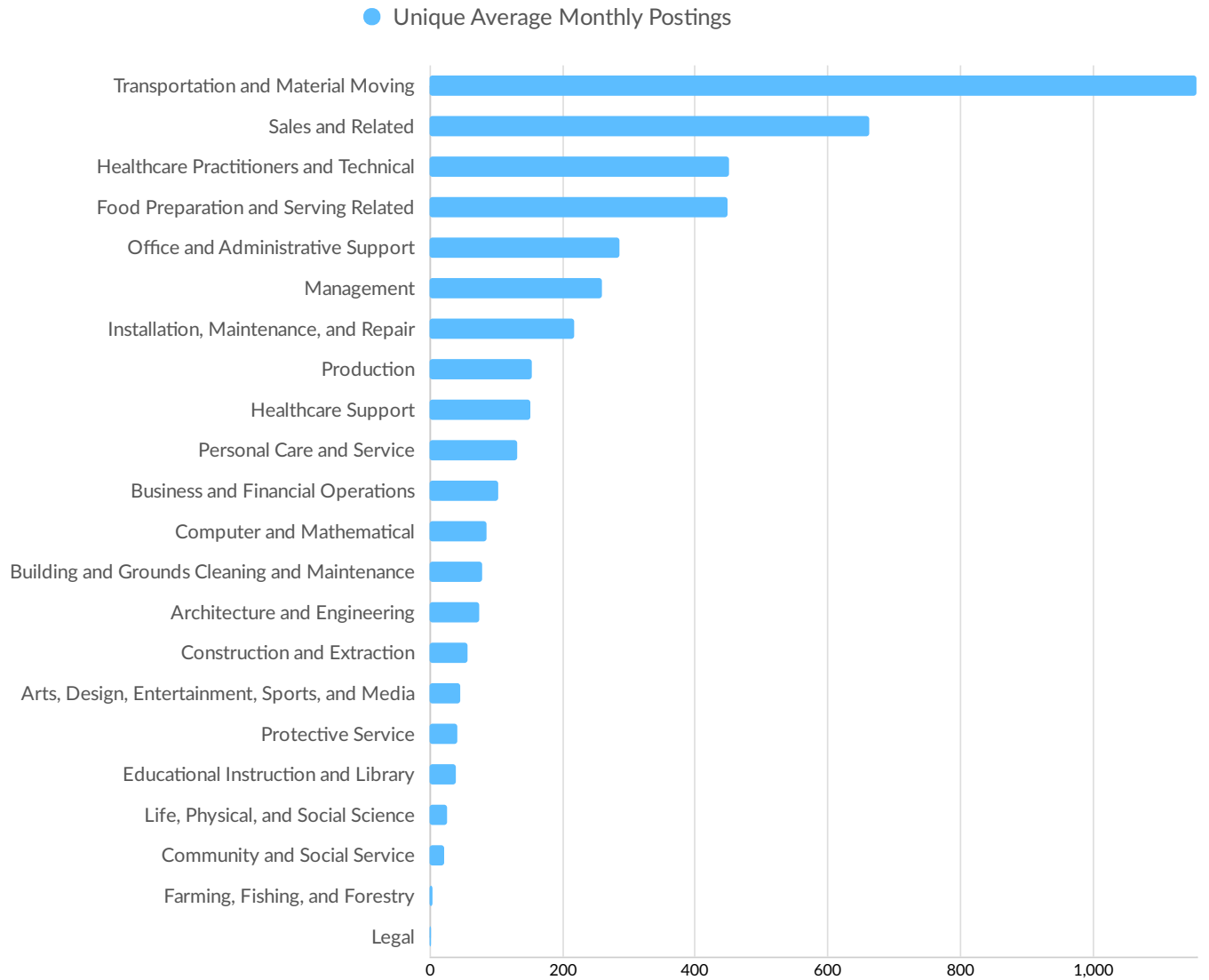
Top Occupation LQ



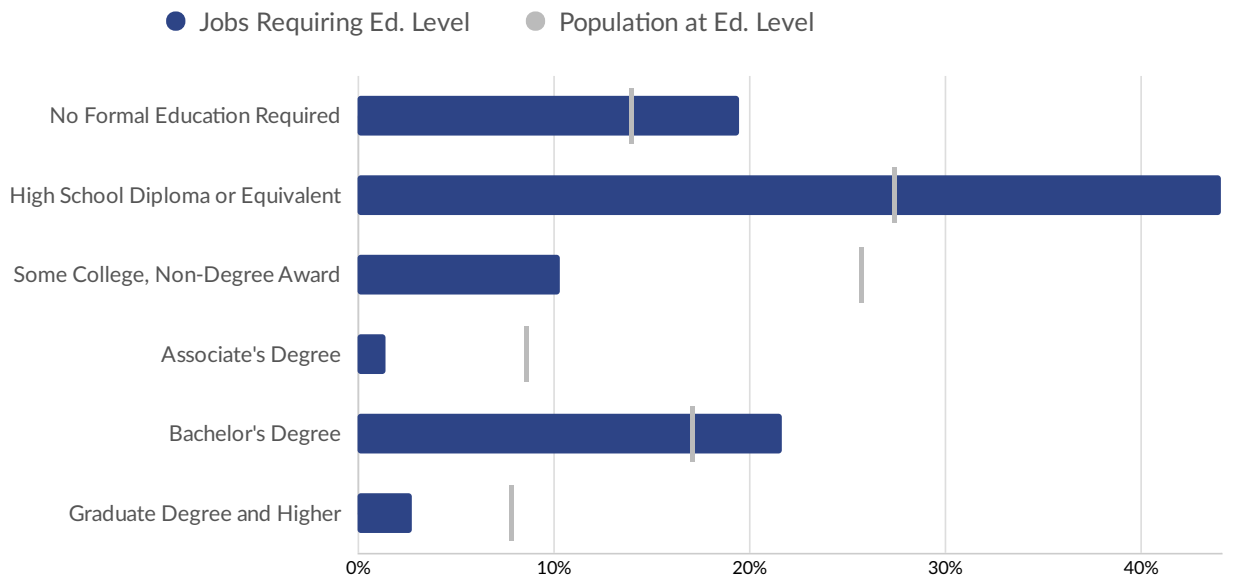
Top Occupation Earnings



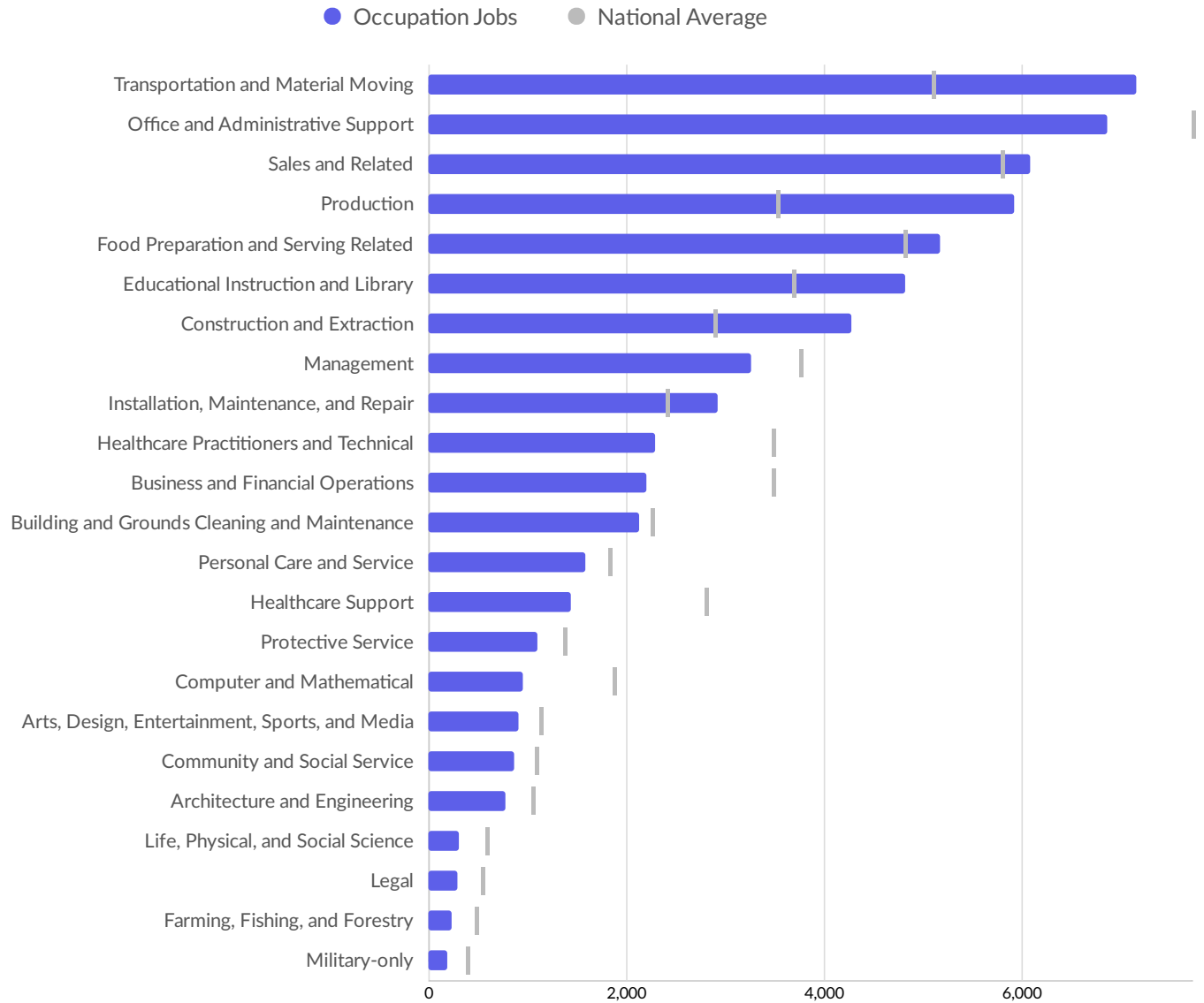

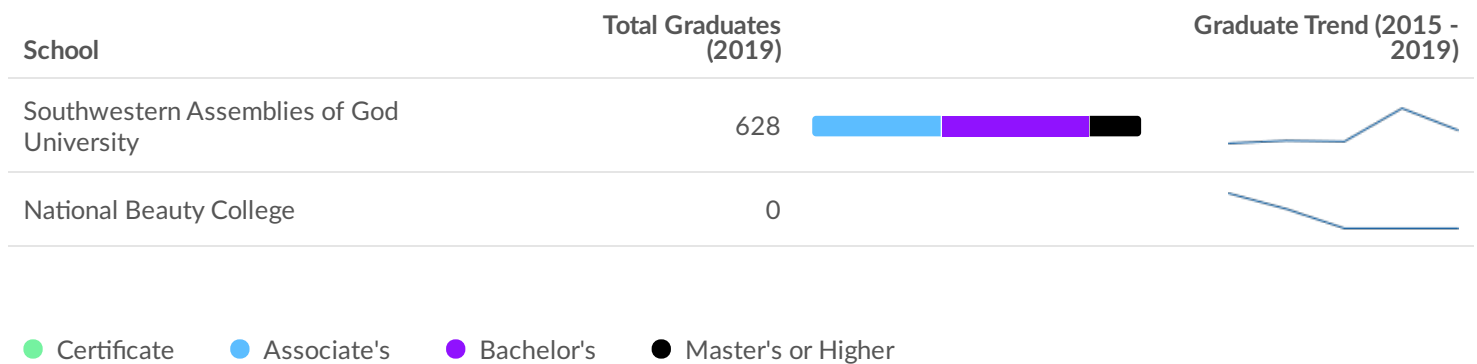
