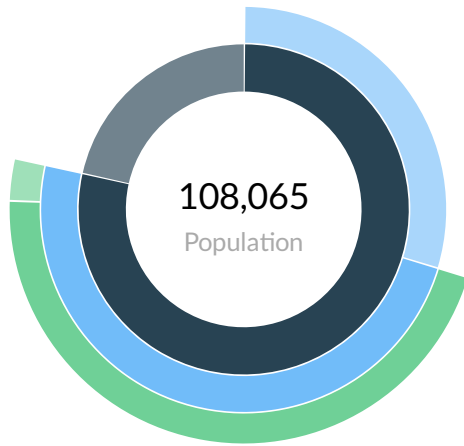

- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **increased by 23.2%** in Rockwall County, TX from 31,186 to **38,434**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.1% by 20.1%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 65.1% to 62.2% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **25.4% of Rockwall County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.3% above the national average), and **9.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.

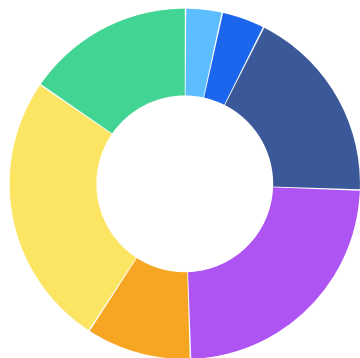

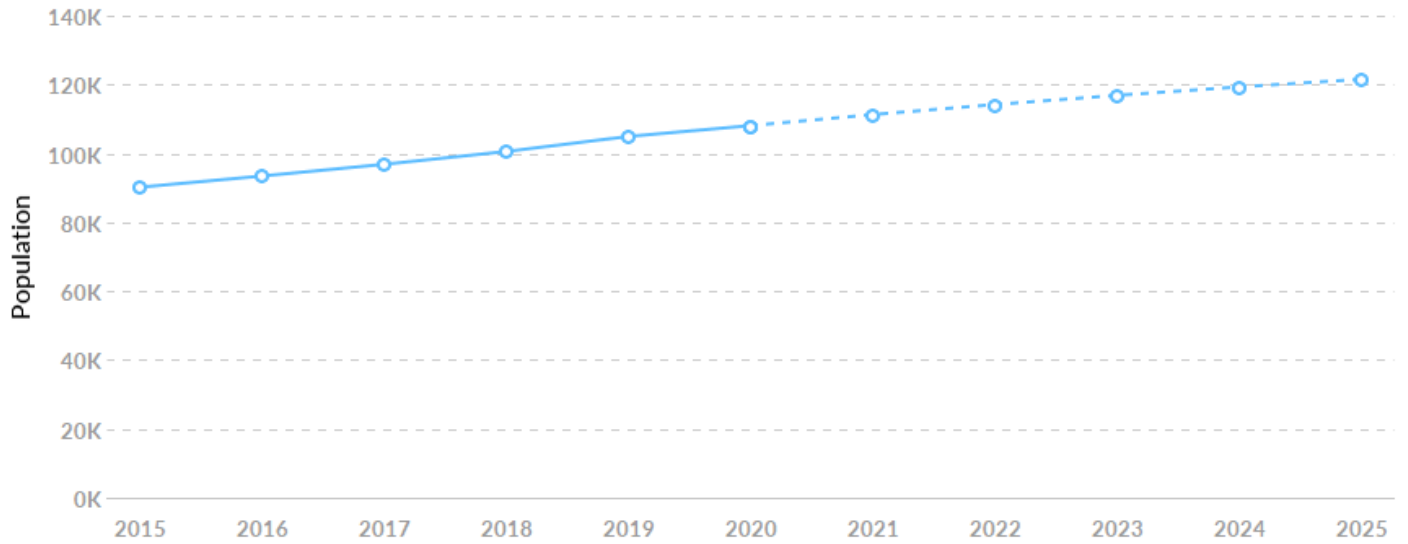

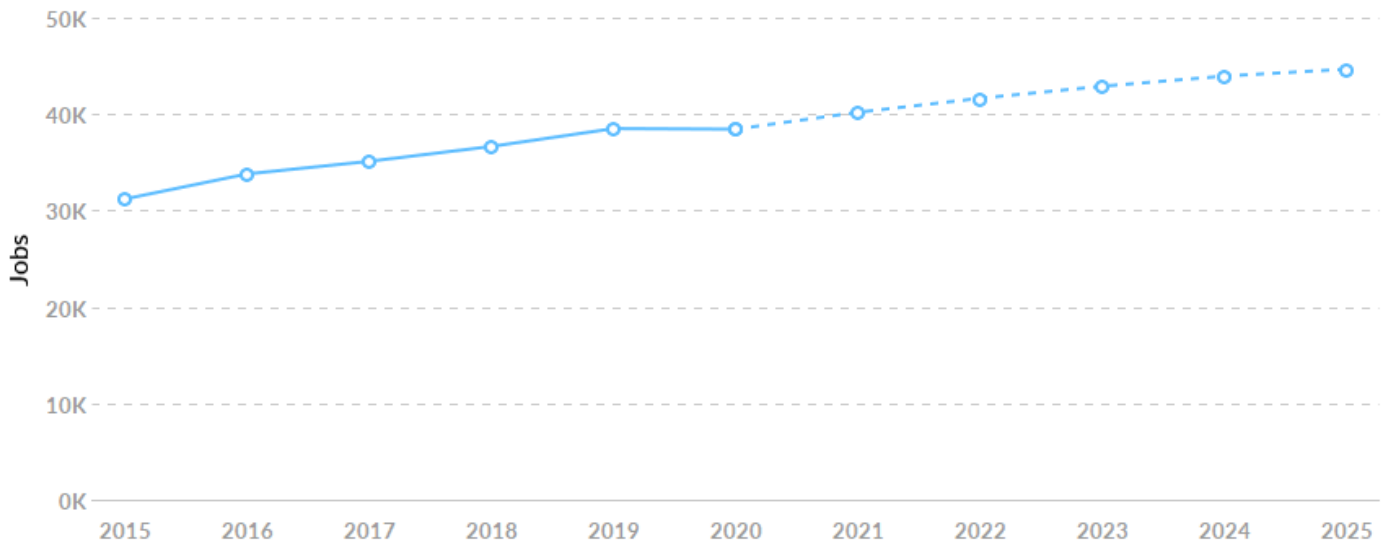

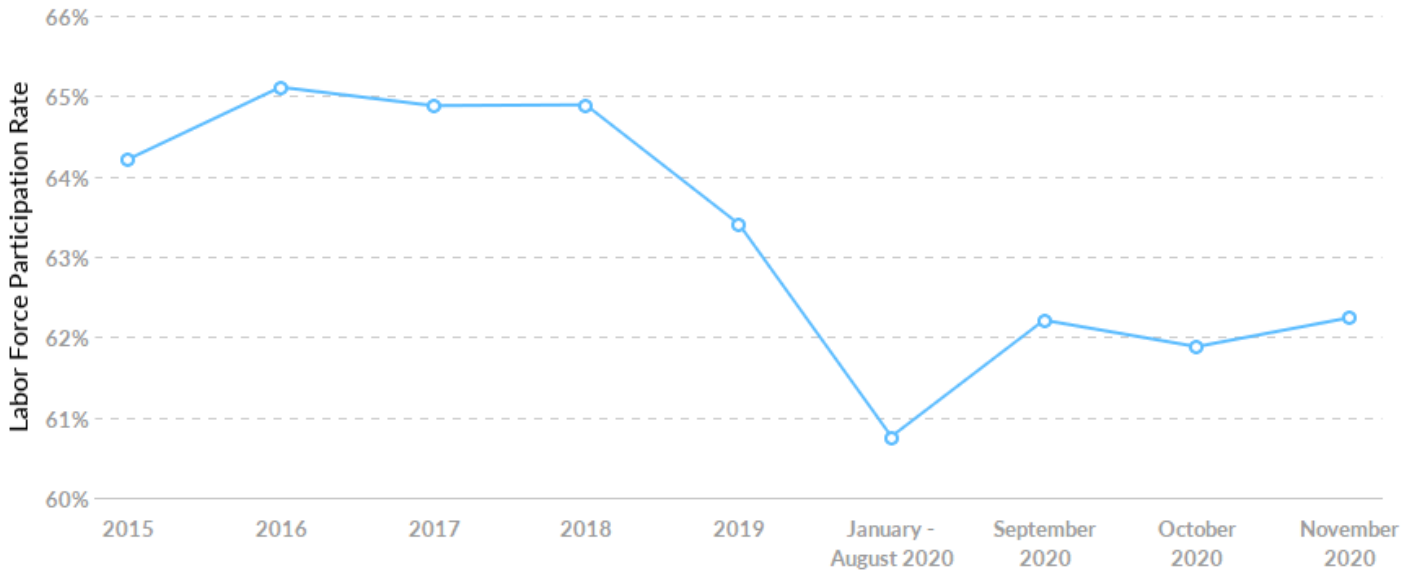
Job Trends

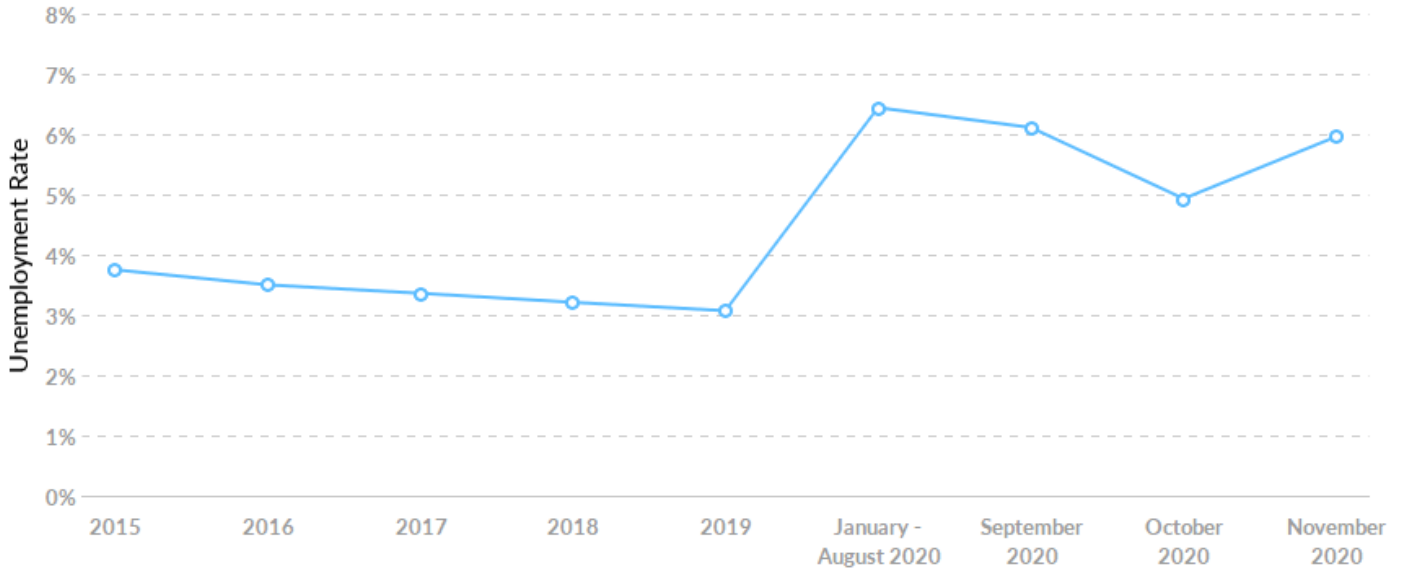

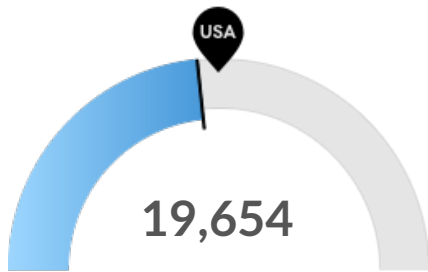
Unemployment Rate Trends

Rockwall County, TX had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 5.96%, **increasing from 3.75%** 5 years before.



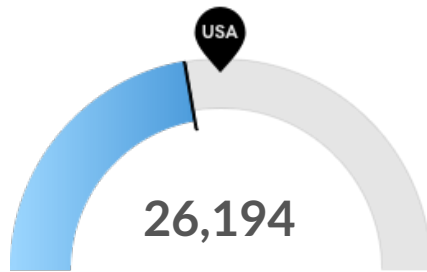

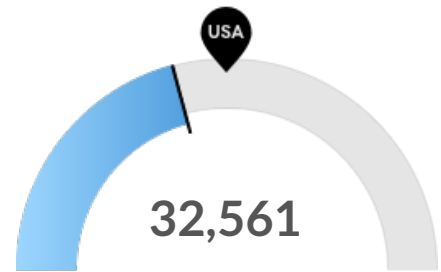
Millennials

Rockwall County, TX has 19,654 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 21,632.



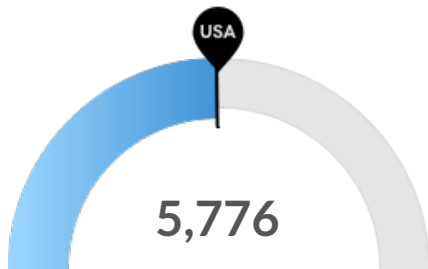
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Rockwall County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 30,846 people 55 or older, while there are 26,194 here.



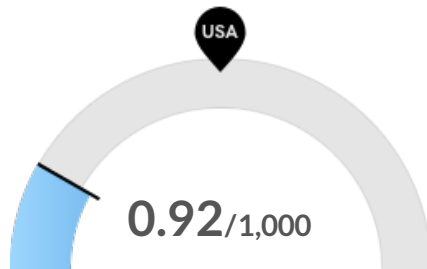
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Rockwall County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 41,849 racially diverse people, while there are 32,561 here.



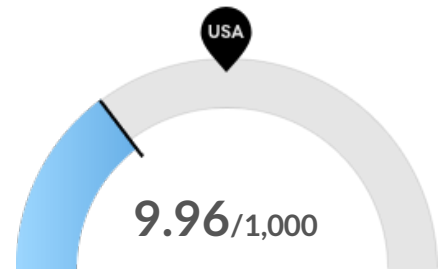
Veterans

Rockwall County, TX has 0.92 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

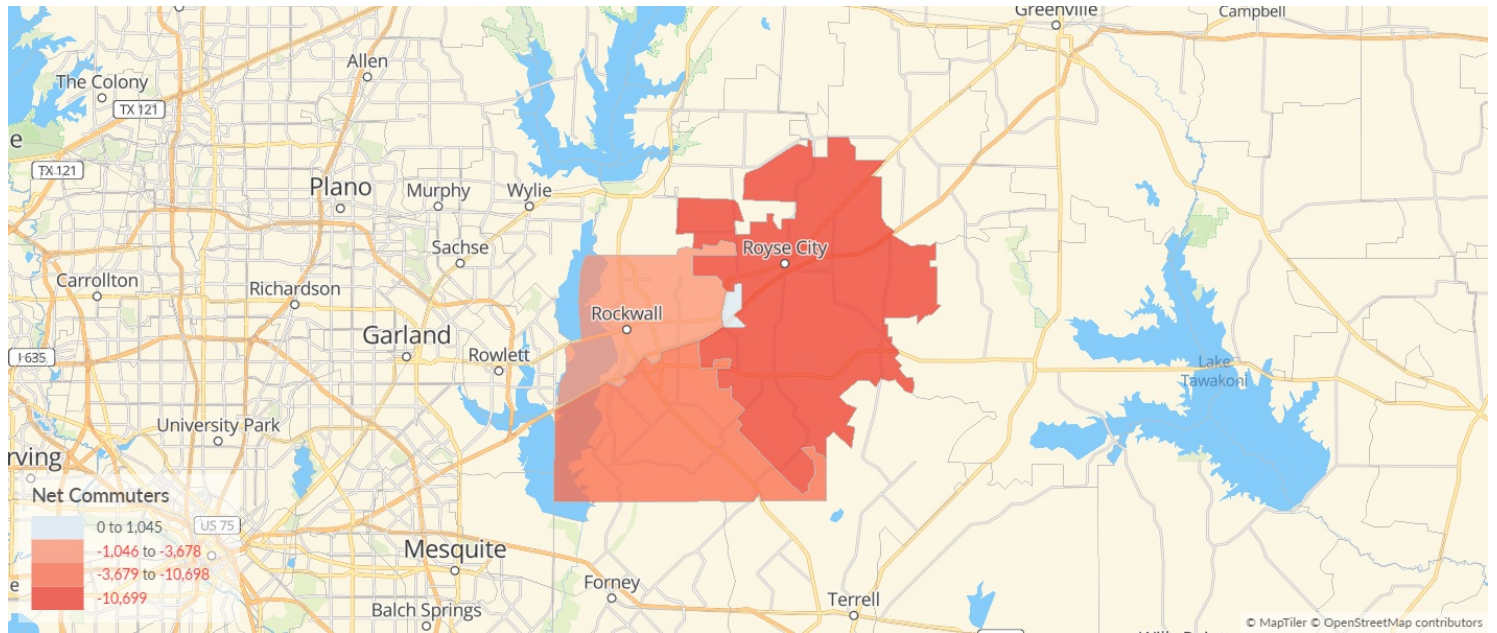


Property Crime

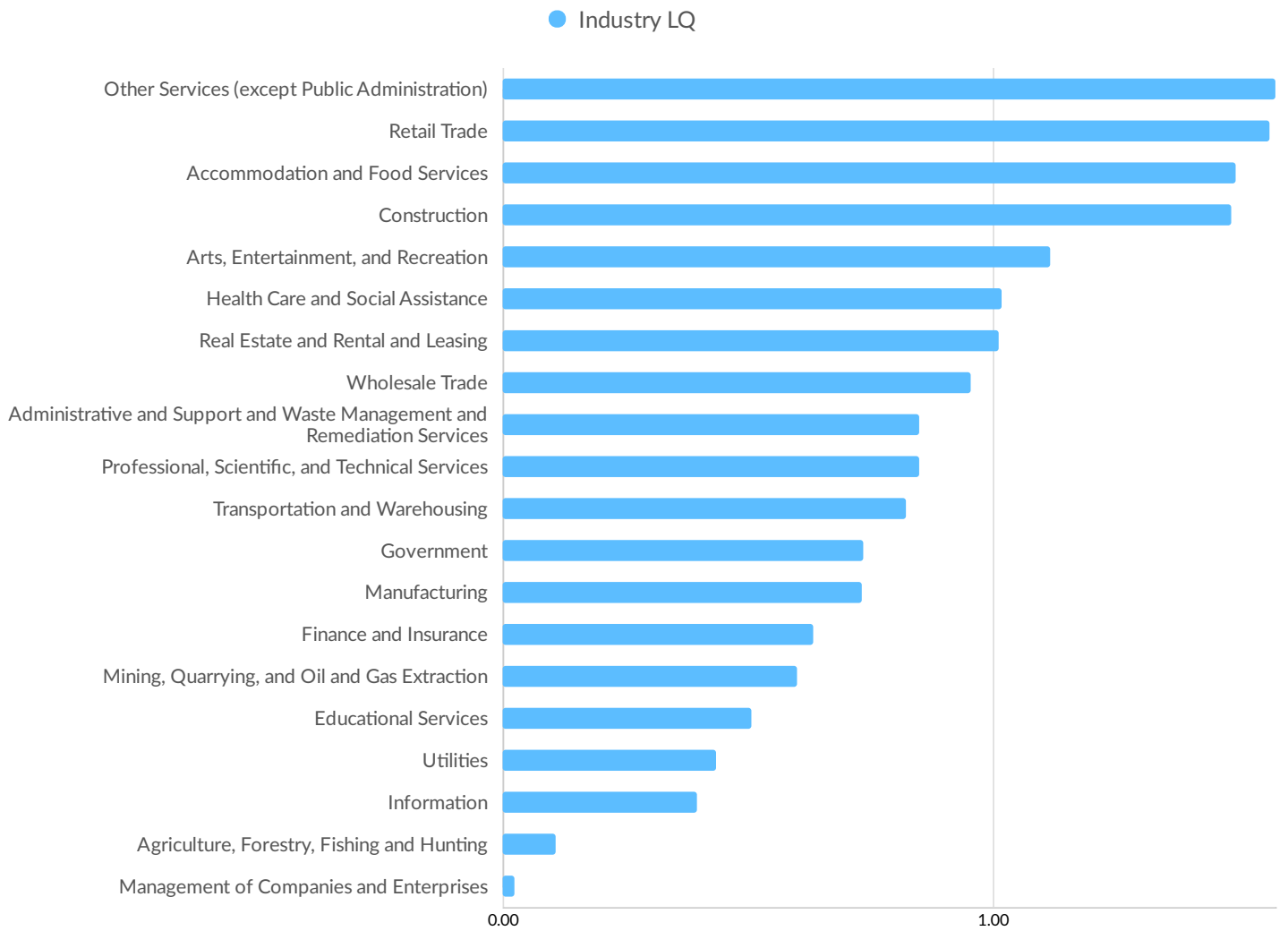

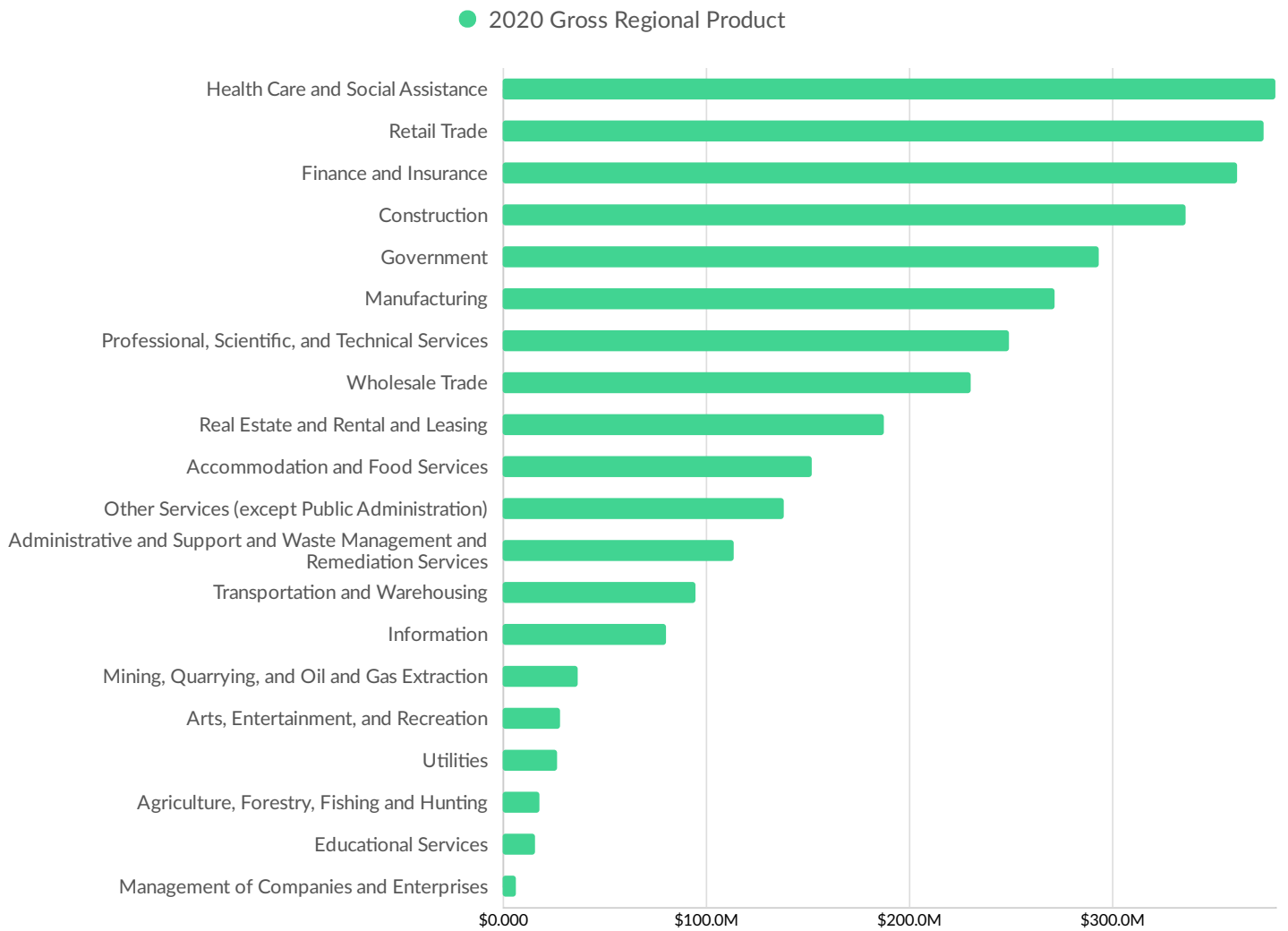
Top Growing Industries



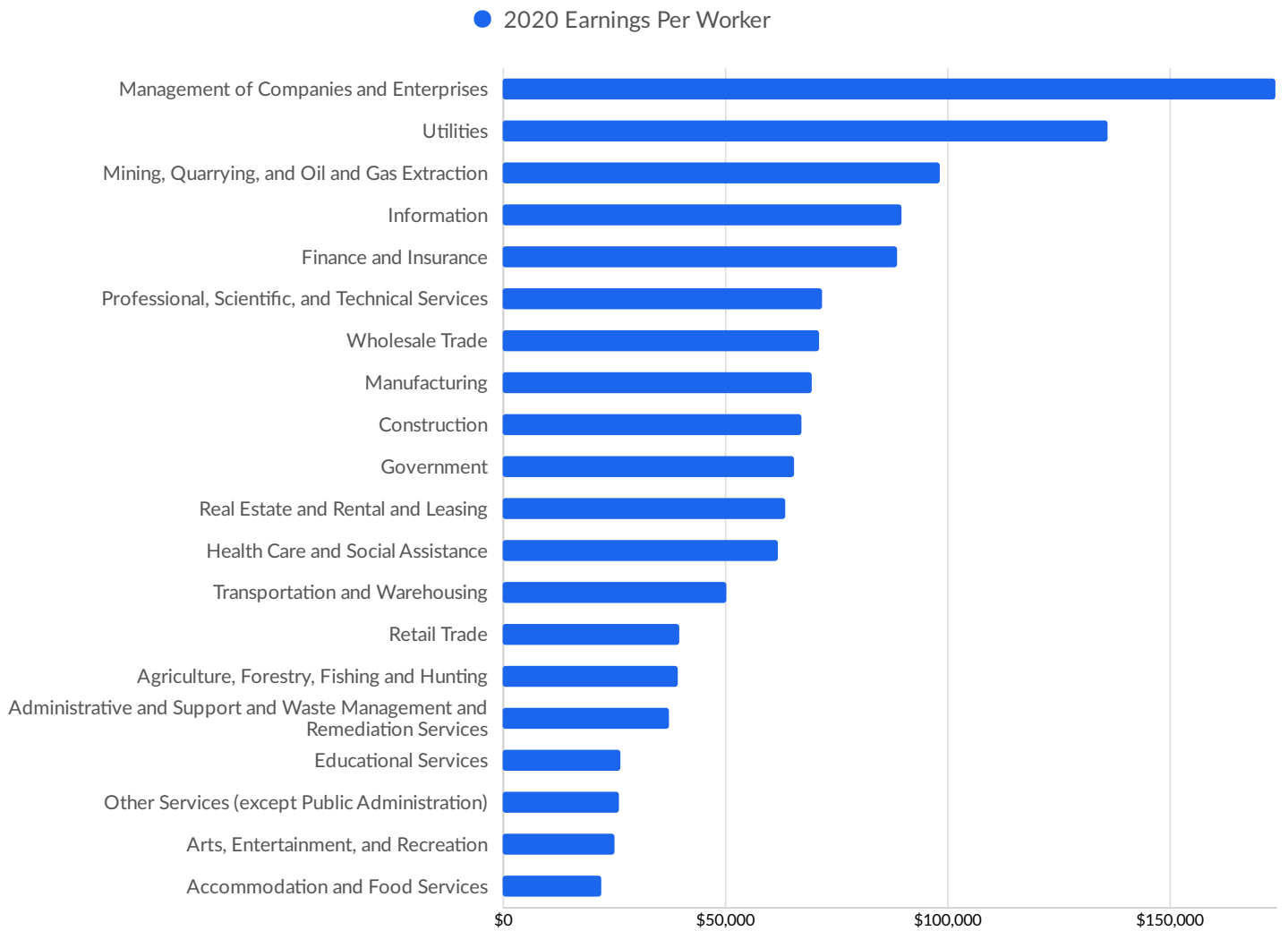

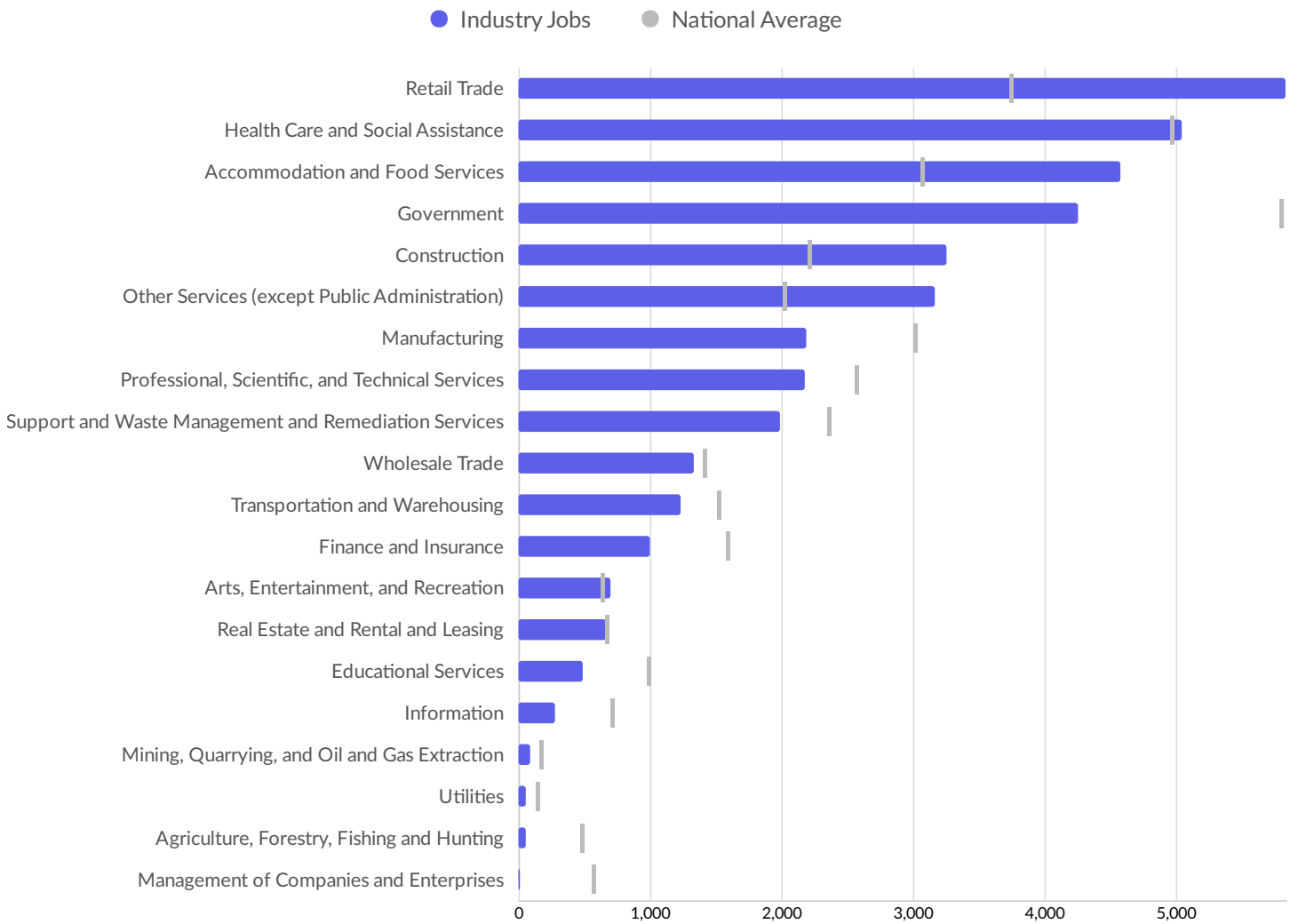

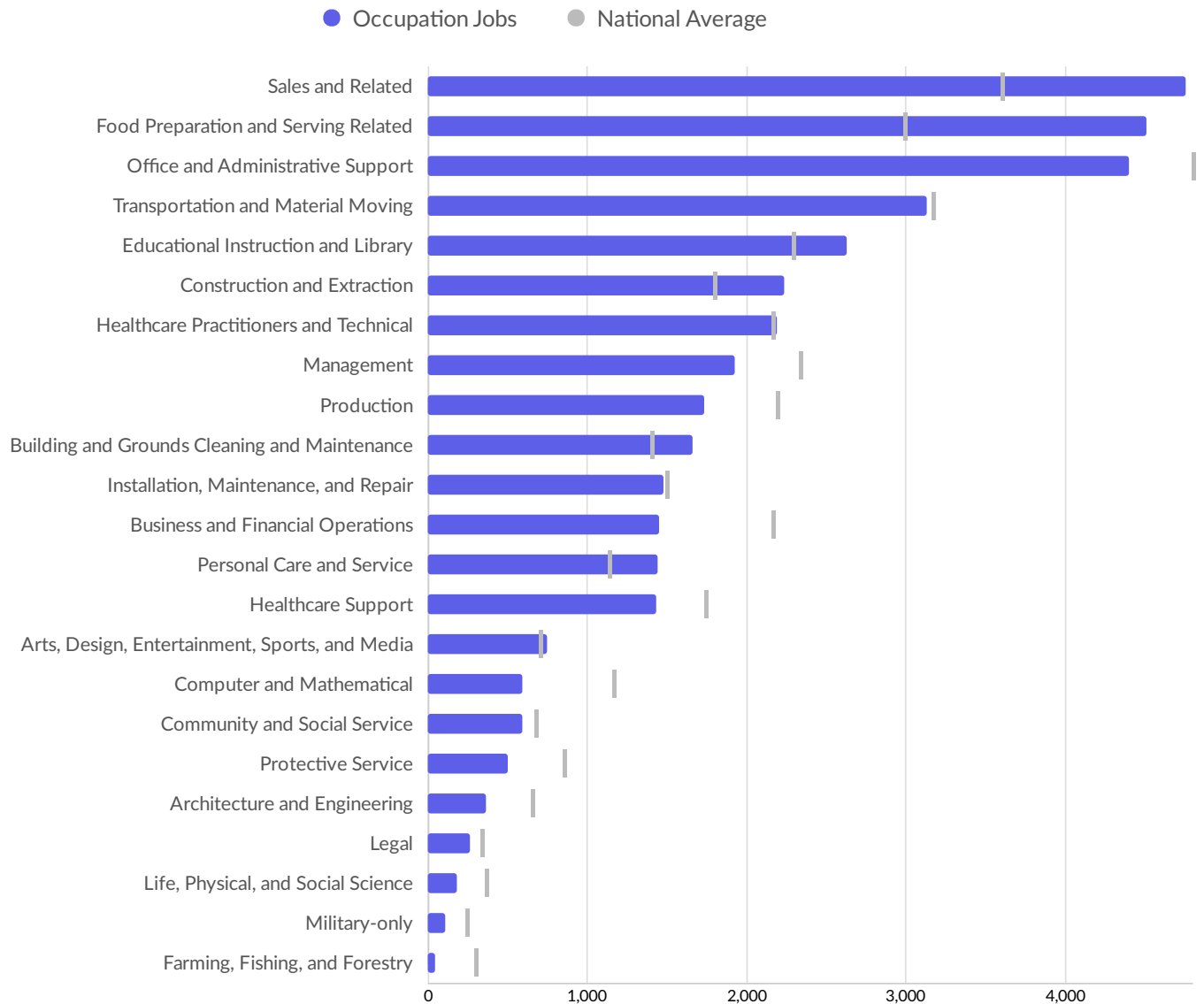

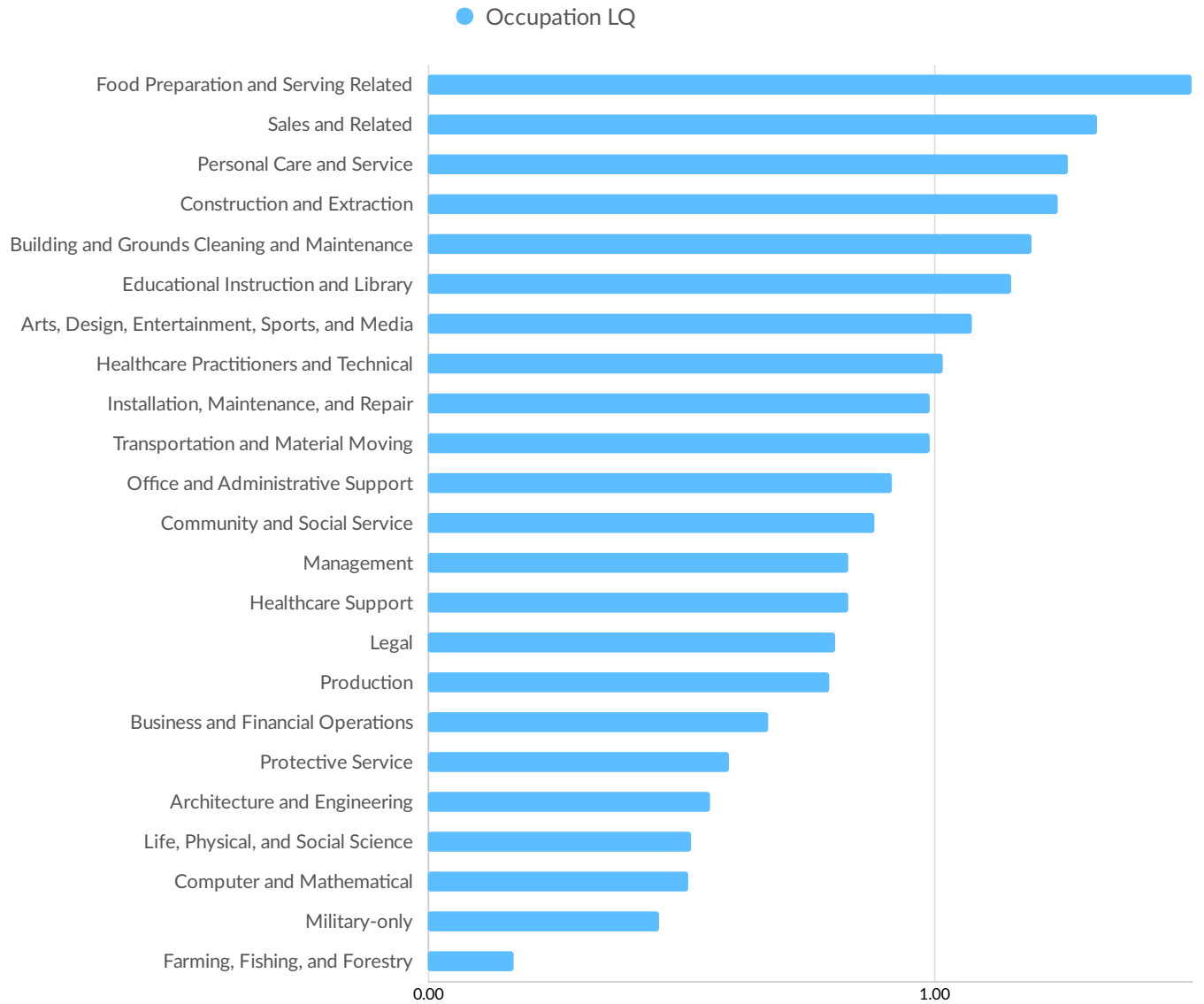

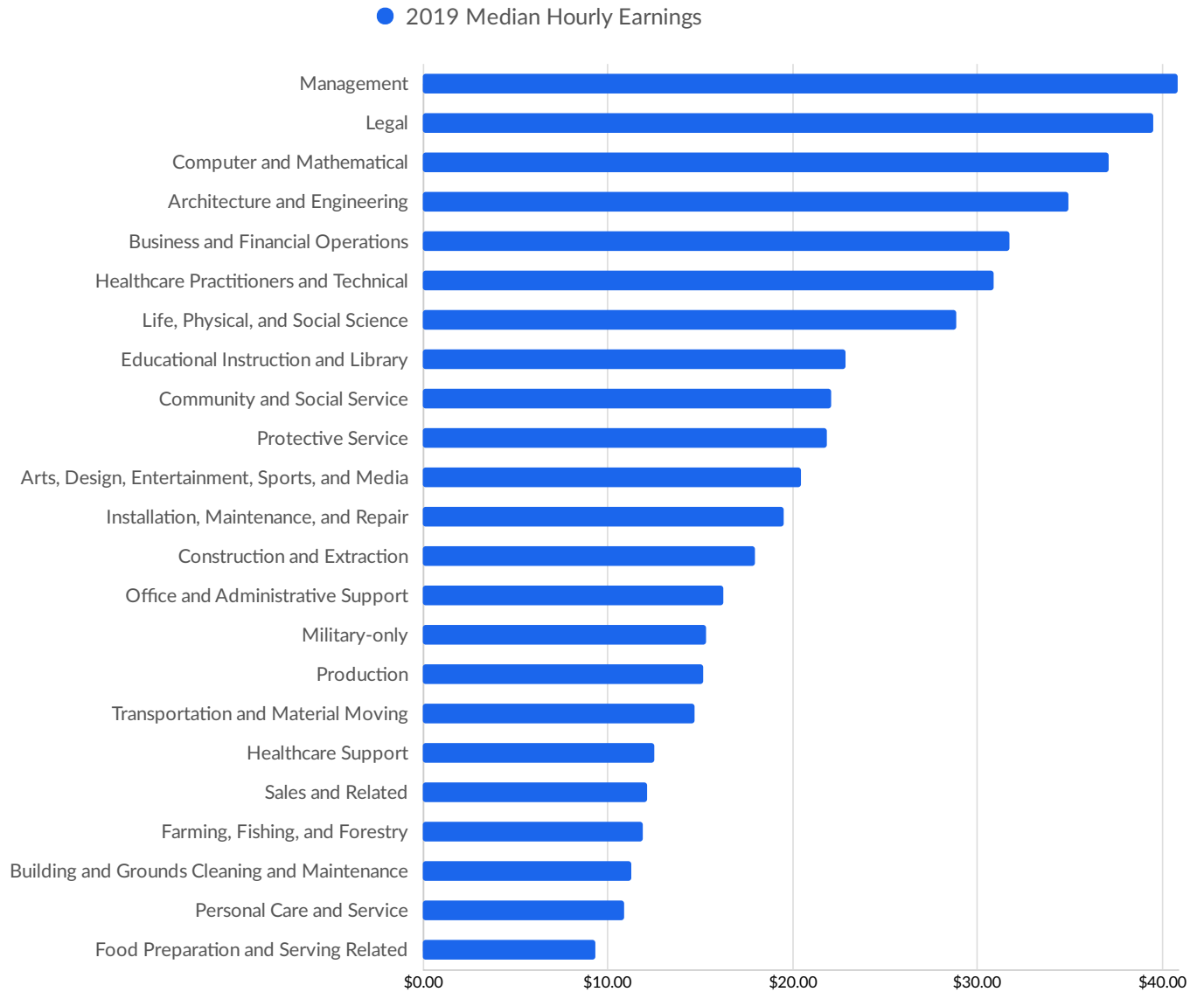

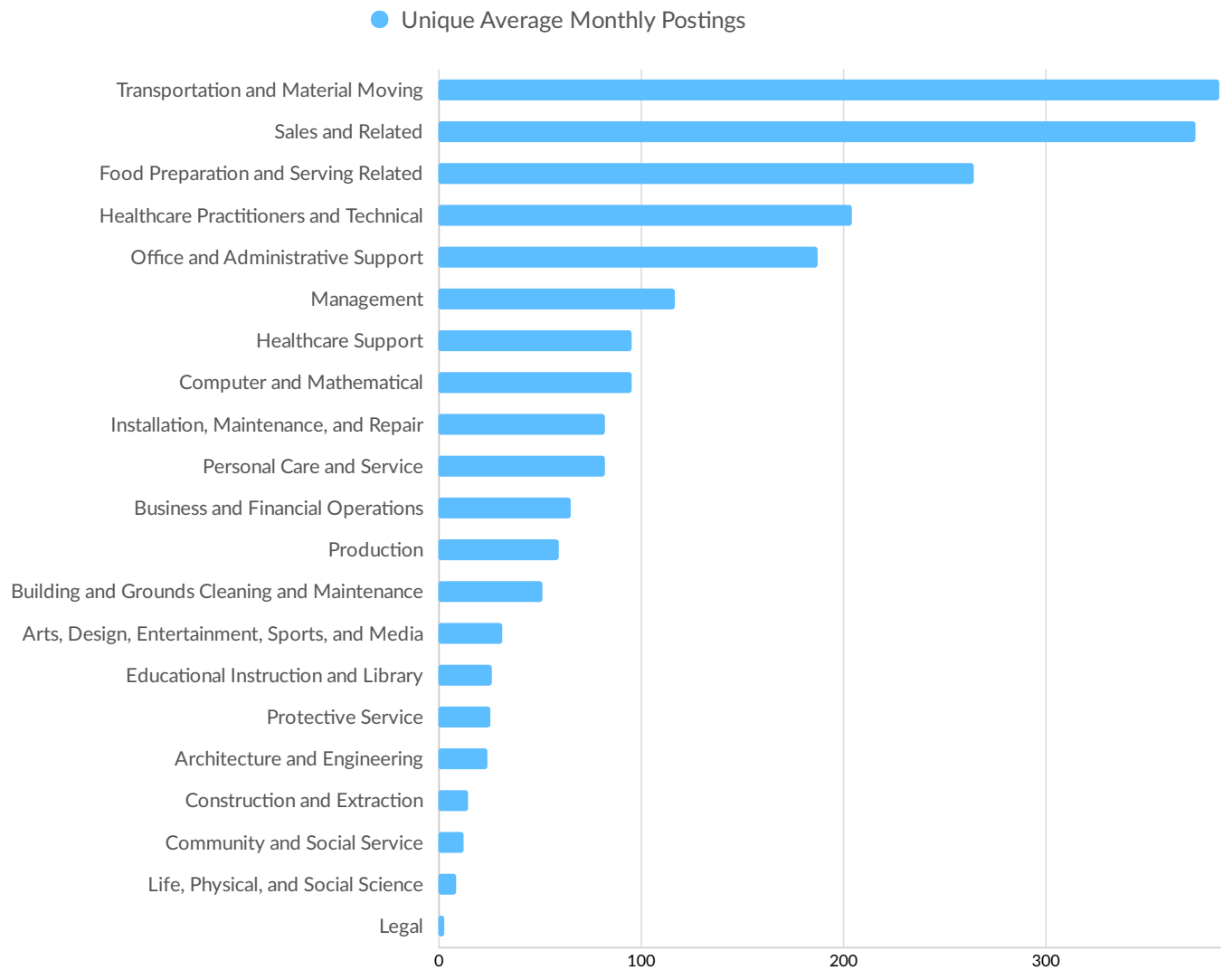

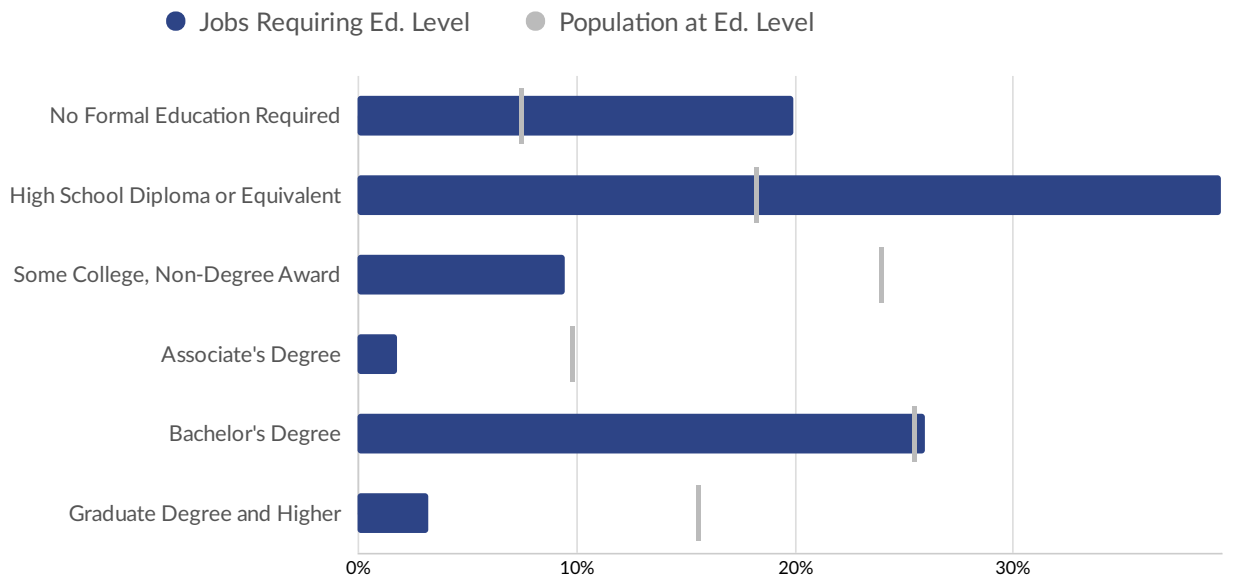

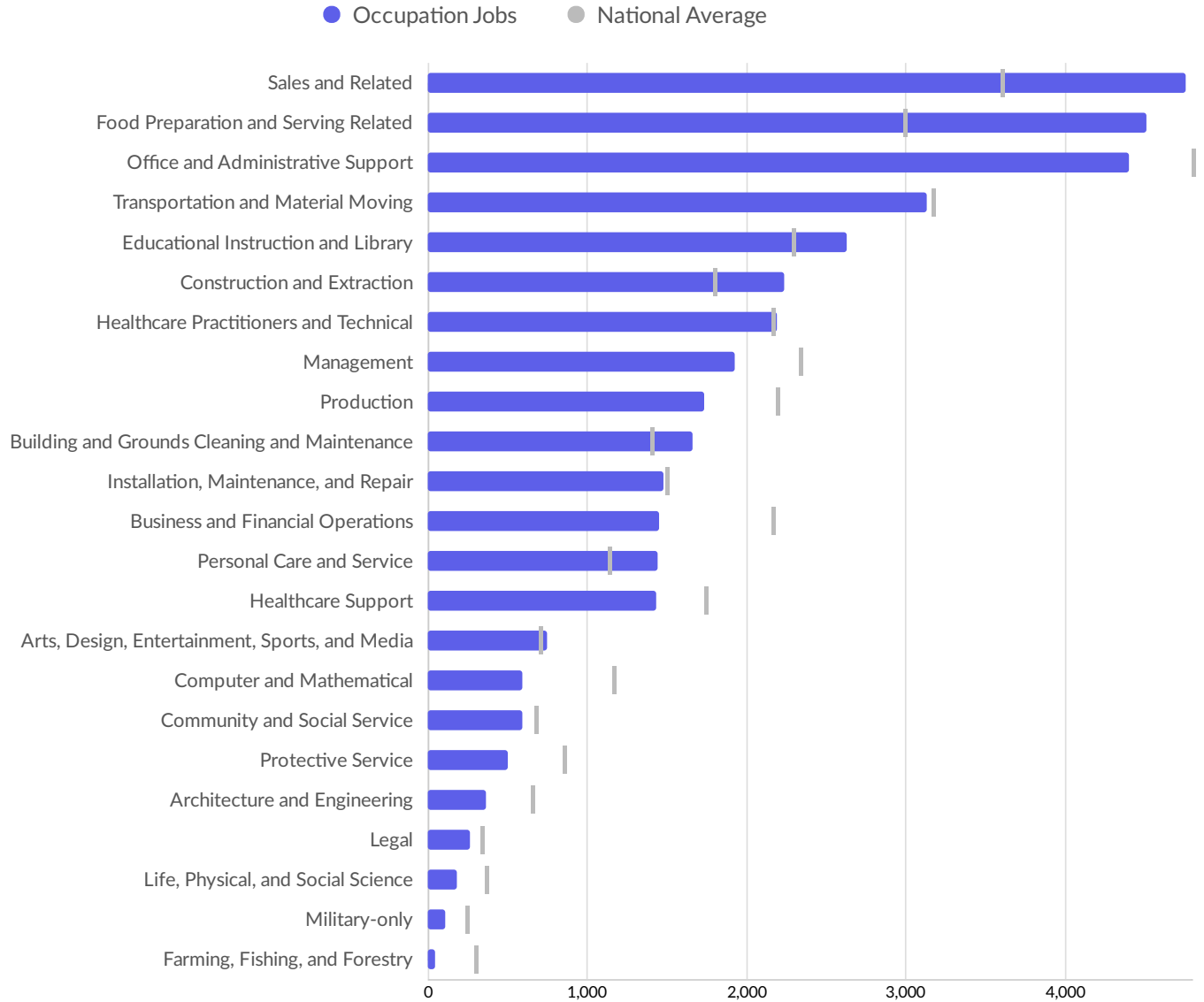
